- Word count 3000 to 5000
- Electronic version, with file extension (either .doc or .rtf)
- Endnotes must follow Chicago Manual of Style, do not insert notes in text
- Illustrations provided with article submissions are welcomed.
- Permission to publish photographs and artwork is the responsibility of the contributor
- A two-three sentence biographical note about the author.

### Copyright policy

The BCHF maintains copyright in author's articles for onetime use only, after which the rights revert to the authors. However, the BCHF reserves the right to digitize the article as it appears in *British Columbia History*, and to reprint it in a future publication. The author may receive one complimentary copy.
